

Headlong into the fire.


Familiar, burning flesh smells sweet; It ne'er will stir again. Ancestors come to warm their bones; And banish this fell sin.

Cosmic Astrology Column

I want to wish everyone a Happy New Year! Themes you can anticipate over the next month involve setting goals, addressing habits, and seeking the best opportunities as the year unfolds. This year marks the 249th birthday of the United States of America. I created an Inceptional Chart to highlight the founding of our nation and how the energy that existed then continues to evolve and resonate today.


The exact time of the U.S. natal chart remains speculative, with the most commonly used rectified chart being one popularized by Ebenezer Sibly (1751–1799), an English physician and occult writer. Known as the "Sibly Chart," it sets the time at 5:10 p.m. EST. This version is the basis for the analysis presented in this article. The included image below is an example of the chart, serving as the foundation for a new divinatory exercise still in its early stages of development.

To begin, take the selected indicator chart and place at the center and layer a Transit Chart found on the outer zodiacal wheel. This method reveals planetary alignments between the two charts and their corresponding houses. Using the whole-sign house division system allows for correlating representations of themes over the upcoming 12 months.

According to the Sibly Chart, the U.S. Ascendant (rising) is in Sagittarius, the Sun is in Cancer, and the Moon is in Aquarius. Using synastry, I will compare the Sibly Chart with the New Year's chart to formulate predictions based on the interactions of aspects and planetary conditions. Emphasis is placed on the closest aspects, as tighter orbs intensify the interplay of energies involved.

In this approach, the First House represents January, the Second House February, and so on, with each house symbolizing a month during one calendar year. The predictions included are my interpretations, and I encourage the skeptical mind to apply the scientific method to test for overall efficacy. If you are new to astrology, I recommend starting with your own Natal Chart to create a personal connection to the topic before proceeding with this method. The ultimate goal is to define the components of your chart and relate them to your interpretations. Then you can begin to formulate your own predictions to enhance the practice.

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January 2025: Transit Mercury at 20.18° Sagittarius



The Thelemic Cookbook: Cooking with Correspondences

From Chapter 34, A Feast in the Sign of Capricorn, side dishes:

Swiss Chard Gruyere Gratin

These fresh and tasty healthy greens get even better with the addition of the cheese and breadcrumb topping, which crisp up an otherwise soft-steamed vegetable. A favorite.

Ingredients

3 pounds chopped Swiss chard, chopped 2 cups grated Gruyere cheese 1 cup yellow onion, chopped 1 teaspoon fresh garlic, minced 2 eggs, beaten 1/4 cup peanut oil 1 cup breadcrumbs 1/4 cup butter, softened 2 tablespoons lemon juice 1/2 teaspoon salt

Directions

1/4 teaspoon white pepper

Thoroughly wash the chard leaves, trim them down the center of their stalks, chop them up and then set aside. Prepare the garlic and onion, and grate the cheese.

In a large frying pan heat 2 tablespoons of oil and sauté the garlic and onions until translucent, and set aside. Put the next two tablespoons of oil in the pan, add the chopped chard and the lemon juice, and cover to lightly steam for 2 to 3 minutes until the chard reduces by half. When done, put the hard in a strainer over the mixing bowl to release the extra liquid and then discard the liquid. Cool down the chard.

In a large mixing bowl beat the eggs and add the onion, the drained chard, and one cup of the grated Gruyere cheese. Mix well and then turn into an oiled 9" \times 13" pan. Mix the second cup of Gruyere cheese, the breadcrumbs, butter, salt, and pepper together to make a crumb and sprinkle it over the top of the chard mixture. Bake in a 375° F (190° C) oven for 30 minutes until the egg sets and the topping becomes a golden brown.

Correspondences

Garlic and white pepper are fire of Mars in Aries, and the onion is water of fire of Mars in Aries. Breadcrumbs of wheat are air of earth of Venus in Taurus. Butter, egg and lemon juice are water of the Moon in Cancer. Peanut oil is fire of Jupiter in Sagittarius, and Swiss chard and Gruyere cheese are earth of Saturn in Capricorn.


